





FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is an API?

An API (Application Programming Interface) is a way to access code or data that someone else has written or stored in a standardized way.

With PitchBook's API, you can bypass the PitchBook Platform and integrate our raw data with your own systems.

With API, you're in complete control to access the exact information you need, any time you want. Once you get the data, you can store and process it within your own internal systems and software.

What is a Datafeed?

Datafeed is perfect solution for firms that need a specific set of data, consistently (for example: all limited partners within a certain region).

This information is delivered by way of a custom file. You can download this file, and import it directly into your systems and applications. We'll update the information on a regular basis-generally daily, weekly or monthly-according to the terms of your contract.

How much do these solutions cost?

Datafeed is priced on a one-time annual subscription based on the scope of information, as well as how often you want this information updated.

PitchBook's API is priced using a pre-paid credit model. As you call on data from PitchBook's API, your credits are spent according to the attributed value of the information as well as the number of calls you make.

I already subscribe to the PitchBook Platform. How does Direct Access work with my existing subscription? Do I still need my PitchBook license?

Both API and Datafeed are available on a stand-alone basis and don't require a PitchBook Platform subscription to use them.

That said, we do recommend that certain clients continue their Platform license. This enables you to access the PitchBook Mobile app, as well as the great search, alert and data viz tools that are included with the PitchBook Platform.

How are these features installed?

Both PitchBook Datafeed and API require a developer to integrate data into your systems in the most cost-effective, efficient and useful ways possible.

While we can't provide these services to you, we can recommend a few contracted developers that have experience using PitchBook's data and building workflow tools and systems for firms like yours.

We also have a dedicated support team to help with technical issues related to API and Datafeed.
